Should there not be a December WestNews, all good wishes to members for a Holy and Happy Christmas season.


### FINAL EVENT FOR 2019

### Notes from St Mary's

Well after quite a busy October, here we are in November!! As I write this, it's Halloween (evening) – and no I haven't gone trick-a-treating.....it's really busy preparing for our All Saints and All Souls services. And I'm looking forward to our new Vocal Ensemble singing the Allegri 'Miserere' this Saturday evening (2<sup>nd</sup> November).

Normally, I like to highlight the activities and achievements of our Cathedral musicians – but this time, I'll mention something of my own activities: early in October I travelled to Melbourne to take part in the Australian Pastoral Musicians Network Conference which is held every 18-24 months. At this conference I gave two presentations – one with a colleague of mine, Donrita Reefman from Victoria, on the actual role of the choir in Catholic liturgy; and the other titled 'How can I help them sing?' in which I talked about the effective use of the pipe organ in Catholic liturgy.

Straight after my presentation on the pipe organ, I ran off for a quick coffee and bumped into another colleague of mine. She enthusiastically asked me 'How did it go?' I was still trying to analyze for myself how it had gone, so I thought aloud: 'Well, no-one yawned or fell asleep – and no-one left – actually, everyone looked really quite engaged and some people were taking lots of notes'. My colleague laughed and said 'it sounds like it went well!!'

Let me share something with you from this presentation – in my preparation of the PowerPoints for these presentations, I came across this charming creature (below) and I just HAD to include him somewhere in my presentation!! He comes with a word of advice for us when we are accompanying choirs:



Let's not be aural hogs!! Make sure we work WITH the choir so we don't overpower them and hog the aural landscape—let's share the atmosphere with them.
